According to Eastern Orthodox Sacred Tradition, the apparition of Mary the Theotokos occurred during the 10th century at the Blachernae church in Constantinople (modern-day Istanbul) where several of her relics (her robe, veil, and part of her belt) were kept. On Sunday, October 1 (14) at four in the morning, St. Andrew the Blessed Fool-for-Christ, who was a Slav by birth, saw the dome of the church open and the Virgin Mary enter, moving in the air above him, glowing and surrounded by angels and saints. She knelt and prayed with tears for all faithful Christians in the world. The Virgin Mary asked Her Son, Jesus Christ, to accept the prayers of all the people entreating Him and looking for Her protection. Once Her prayer was completed, She walked to the altar and continued to pray. Afterwards, She spread Her veil over all the people in the church as a protection. St. Andrew turned to his disciple, St. Epiphanius, who was standing near him, and asked, "Do you see, brother, the Holy Theotokos, praying for all the world?" Epiphanius answered, "Yes, Holy Father, I see it and am amazed!"

According to the Primary Chronicle of St. Nestor the Chronicler, the inhabitants of Constantinople called upon the intercession of the Mother of God to protect them from an attack by a large Rus' army (Rus' was still pagan at the time). According to Nestor, the feast celebrates the destruction of this fleet sometime in the ninth century. The Feast of the Intercession commemorates the miracle as a joyous revelation of the Theotokos' protection, which is spread over the world, and the Mother of God's great love for mankind. It is a religious holy day or feast day of the Byzantine Rite Eastern Orthodox Churches. It is not found in Oriental Orthodoxy nor Western Rite Orthodoxy though it is perfectly consistent with the theology and beliefs of these sister churches. It is held annually on October 14, which corresponds to October 1 on the "Old Style calendar" i.e. the Julian calendar still used in some Eastern Orthodox Churches. It is served as an All-Night Vigil, with many of the same elements as occur on Great Feasts of the Theotokos.

In Ukraine, it is celebrated on October 14 as a religious, national, and family holiday. The Mother of God as the Intercessor and Patron became firmly established among Ukrainians: princes, kings, cossacks, and hetmans chose the Mother of God as their patroness and protectress. An icon in the National Art Museum of Ukraine shows the Virgin Mary protecting the Ukrainian cossack hetman Bohdan Khmelnytsky. By decree of the Ukrainian President, October 14 — Pokrova Feast Day was promulgated also as Ukrainian Cossack Day (Ukrainian: День Українського козацтва).

There she received an education in business, at a school established at a refugee camp. She married Walter Krop in 1947, in Salzburg. They immigrated together to the United States, in 1949, where they made their first home in St. Johnsville, New York. Their first son Bohdan Krop was born in Little Falls, in 1952. Shortly after they moved to Utica, where they became members of St. Volodymyr Ukrainian Catholic Church, on Cottage Place. Their second son Roman was born in 1955. Her beloved husband, Walter Krop died on January 21, 2003. She resided independently after her husband's death until 2019. She then blessed the home of her son, Bohdan and daughter in law, Betty Krop in Turin, NY. Josephine passed on to her reward peacefully while surrounded by her loving family on September 22, 2021. She is survived by her two sons and daughters in law, Bohdan and Betty Krop and Roman and Sherri Kropp; also surviving are 10 grandchildren, 35 great grandchildren, three great-great grandchildren and her dear friend, Linda Millard, Betty's sister, who also resides with them.

Anastazja Bindas, 81, the mother of Anna Bundz, passed away Thursday, September 16, 2021. Funeral services were held in the Ukrainian Catholic Church of Dormition in Koszalin, Poland on Wednesday, September 22, 2021. The services were performed by dear family friends, Fr. Miłrat Bogdan Haluszka and Fr. Miłrat Bogdan Pipka.

Anastazja was born on December 28, 1939, the youngest of four, to Dmytro and Anna Malyj (Szaryj) in the village of Jawornik in south-east Poland, bordering Ukraine. The family was re-settled to north-west Poland in 1947 during "Akcja Wisła." Her village and the local church have been destroyed with no surviving records.

Anastazja met her husband Roman in 1957 and they were married on September 28, 1958. They raised five daughters in their family home in Gleznowko, Northern Poland. For many years she successfully managed their farm. Anastazja worked hard and enjoyed tending to her private garden filled with all types of flowers and vegetables. Her grandchildren will never forget her kindness, love and the warmth of her kitchen where she made her famous pierogi and "kopytka." She was lucky to meet her 6th great-grandchild weeks before her passing.

Anastazja is survived by her husband of 63 years, Roman, children, Anna (s-i Fr. Michael Bundz), Krystyna (s-i Boguslaw Iwancio), Joanna (s-i Mirosław Stachnik), Maria, and Irena (s-i Andrzej Senko). Her grandchildren Michael (Hayley), Ihor (Kasia), Marta (Daniel), Mateusz (Olga), Daria (Mateusz), Pawel, Kasia (Stefan), and Roksana; and her great-grandchildren: John, Gregory, Lena, Nestor, Anton, and Ignas. She also leaves many relatives in Poland, Iceland, Canada and USA.

Покров Пресвятої Богородиці – одне з найважливіших християнських свят у році, яке відзначається 14 жовтня. Воно входить до числа дванадесятих і тому зовсім не дивно, що з таким торжеством пов'язана дуже цікава історія і величезна кількість традицій і прикмет. До речі, повна назва свята - Покрова Пресвятої Владичиці нашої Богородиці і Приснодіви Марії. Це свято почало відзначатися відносно (для християнських) нещодавно, тільки в 10 столітті. Покров Пресвятої Богородиці з'явився на честь події, яка сталася у 910 році у Влахернському храмі, 14 жовтня, до речі, саме тому і дата святкування така. Легенда розповідає, що тоді йшла війна, і Константинополь був оточений сарацинами і вже не міг тримати оборону. Всі люди сховалися в єдиному безпечному місці в місті - в головному храмі. Там вони молилися про порятунок на чолі з блаженним Андрієм і його учнем Єпіфанієм. І тоді юродивому Андрію, який служив у храмі і був дуже побожним, сталося видіння. Над людьми, які молилися, з'явилася Богородиця. Вона спустилася з-під купола храму в супроводі Іоанна Богослова і Іоанна Предтечі і вони почали молитися разом з людьми про порятунок міста. Після цього, вона зняла з себе омофор (покрив - одяг, який носять на плечах) і накрила ним всіх людей, які молилися. І завдяки цьому візантійці зуміли стримати оборону і відбитися. З того моменту вони жили у мирі, і відзначали Покрову Пресвятої Богородиці щорічно 14 жовтня. <https://znaj.ua/society/pokrovpresvyatoyi-bogorodyci>
